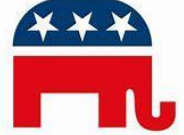

Scholarship Rules & Regulations

The Republican Party of Lee County understands the challenges that our County has and continues to face. The future of our County will rest with our children and young adults. We believe that assisting them with their post-secondary education is a worthwhile investment. We also understand that this journey can be financially burdensome. The Republican Party is proud to assist our County's students with this process with our 5th Annual Republican Party Scholarship.

About: Two (2) post-secondary educational scholarships will be awarded to graduates of Lee County Public Schools. One (1) will be awarded to a graduate of Lee High School and one (1) will be awarded to a graduate of Thomas Walker High School.

Amount: The scholarship will be in the amount of \$500.00 per scholarship. There will be a one time payment of \$500.00 made directly to the institution in which the award recipient is attending.

Eligibility: Students must be a part of the current graduating class from Thomas Walker High School or Lee High School with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Scholarships must be used to attend a post-secondary college, university, or vocational school.

Details: Students must submit three (3) documents:

Background page (Not to exceed 1 page) - Briefly tell us about yourself and any extra-curricular activities that you have participated in, awards received, employment, volunteer hours, etc. This will give the judges an understanding of your character and work ethic.

Goals page (Not to exceed 1 page) - Briefly describe what your future aspirations are and how this scholarship will assist in achieving your goals.

Project: (300-1000 words) - You have been tasked with a project to boost interest and participation in new voters and young adults. The goal of this project is to get young adults excited and interested in the voting process, becoming informed voters, and the importance of being involved. Please describe what you would do to best accomplish this and why.

Students will submit these typed documents with their **Student ID number** at the top of each page (**No Student Names**). This will assist in keeping the selection process fair to all students.

Deadline: All documents must be dropped off or emailed to your Guidance Counselor's office by 4:00 P.M. on **April 21, 2023**. Please send all documents in one email to keep documents together.
